Who Can Attend?

- Inner-city pastors and lay leaders seeking theological education
- Established leaders, church planters, and urban ministry volunteers
- Those who are called to serve God in the city context

The Ideal Student:

- Urban pastors (who desire further training)
- Lay leaders seeking theological education and training
- Established leaders, church planters, and/or urban ministry volunteers
- Those who are called to serve God in the city (urban) context
- Those encouraged by a local pastor to train for urban missions

TUMI is NOT for the following:

- New Converts
- Lone Ranger Christians
- Those interested in theory and/or theological debates
- Those seeking training for suburban or rural ministries

As the urban population in America continues to grow, we believe the urban church leader will be essential part of God's Kingdom advancing in the city. Therefore, we will do all we can to equip and empower leaders.

What Should I Expect?

- Classes meet for 2 hours one day a week for 8 weeks (there are 16 modules to complete)
- Instruction through DVD
- Class discussion and interaction with class mentor/facilitator
- Weekly course readings and assignments
- Class size is generally limited to 15 people
- Both English and Spanish classes are available

How Much Does It Cost?

- \$100 per course (covers, tuition, workbook & all required textbooks)
